At a TEDx event, speakers provoke deep discussions and connect with each other. These local, self-organized events are called TEDx, where x = independently organized TED event. The TED conference provides general guidance for the TEDx program, but individual TEDx events are self-organized. (Subject to certain rules and regulations.)
