Of course, Louvre has been slightly altered by the presence of tourists, which is why Kafka rarely comes by... Have you reflected on the line "Someone must have slandered K because one day he got himself arrested"? I know how strongly you admire Kafka and how long you have been feeding off his novels, his universe. One day, you must come to Prague, stand on the Charles Bridge and watch the former royal palace, a huge citadel, actually overwhelming, situated on a hill on the left bank of the Vltava river, dominating the entire city. This palace, better described as a fortress, one of the greatest in Central Europe, is an actual labyrinth of yards and buildings, a monument of austerity in total contrast with the exuberance full of baroque echoes reverberating from the rest of the city.
